

Summary of Meaningful Use Stage 2 Requirements for Eligible Professionals (EPs)

Below are the measures on which EPs will have to successfully report to demonstrate meaningful use in Stage 2. The Stage 1 requirements are presented for comparison to illustrate how the program is advancing.
